



HYPERTENSION CANADA'S MENTORSHIP AWARD

Deadline for nominations – May 15, 2020

Hypertension Canada is pleased to invite all members to submit nominations for the 2020 Mentorship Award. Mentoring is recognized as the most significant way to grow and nurture young members of the hypertension community. A great mentor helps transition young investigators to the role of educator and supports the implementation of evidence-based practices. The Mentorship Award recognizes the generosity of time and talents an individual provides to students' in their scientific, clinical and leadership placement experiences. The Award consists of a plaque from Hypertension Canada and is given annually to individuals if suitable candidates are nominated. If no suitable candidates are nominated the award may be withheld in any given year.

Eligibility: Eligible candidates are current volunteers of Hypertension Canada. Members of the Hypertension Canada Awards Committee and Board are not eligible.

Selection Criteria and Process: Eligible individuals must be nominated. Nominations are valid only for the year in which the nomination is submitted. There is no limit on the number of individuals that may be recognized in a given year. An individual may only receive the Mentorship Award once.

A letter of nomination and supporting documents must be submitted electronically to Hypertension Canada prior to the nomination deadline to be considered. Submissions received after the deadline will not be considered.

The letter of nomination should clearly outline the extent, duration and the impact of contributions that were made by the nominee.

Selection: The Awards Committee will review the letters of nomination and documents submitted in support of the nominations and will select recipients by consensus.

The awards will be presented to the successful candidates at a ceremony during the Canadian Hypertension Congress, taking place September 24 – 26 at The DoubleTree by Hilton, Montreal, Quebec.

The **deadline for submission of these nominations is May 15, 2020.**
Submissions received after the deadline will not be considered.
