Hypertension Canada is honoured to recognize Dr. Nuyt's substantial contributions to the hypertension community with the 2016 Certificate of Excellence. Her accomplishments are many: Dr. Nuyt is Immediate Past President of the Quebec Hypertension Society, and Professor, Department of Pediatrics, as well as Associate Member, Department of Physiology, Université de Montréal and Chief, Division of Neonatology and Head, Fetomaternal and Neonatal Pathologies Research Axis, CHU Sainte-Justine Research Center and Associate Scientific Director, CARTaGENE, 2015.

Dr. Nuyt's research studies focus on the mechanisms underlying the developmental origins of pathologies appearing in adulthood, including hypertension. More specifically, on how oxidative stress suffered during the perinatal period can alter the functional and structural development of the cardiovascular system.

The Certificate of Excellence Award is only one example of the much-deserved recognition Dr. Nuyt has received throughout her career. She is a true leader in the quest for improving the health of all Canadians.

The 2016 Certificate of Excellence recognizes Dr. Tremblay's distinguished career in developing innovations in medical education locally, nationally and internationally. In recent years, he has focused his attention on closing the gap between medical knowledge and clinical practice. Most notable has been his efforts to implement the greater use of atherosclerotic risk engines as reflected both in the guidelines as well as in their applications. Specifically, Dr. Tremblay has taken the lead role in the introduction of the SCORE risk engine to Canada and promoted its widespread adoption to improve atherosclerotic risk factor control in Canada.

Dr. Tremblay has demonstrated an exceptional commitment and outstanding contributions to the field of hypertension prevention and control.
