

HYPERTENSION CANADA'S HYPERTENSION INNOVATIONS AWARD

Deadline for nominations – January 17th, 2025

Hypertension Canada is pleased to invite all members to submit nominations for the 2025 Hypertension Innovations Award. The annual award recognizes a member that develops or leads implementation of innovative approaches in knowledge translation and education related to hypertension and/or primary prevention. Examples of such work could include the development of an innovative webinar, a novel resource, a new means of dissemination, or advances in the development of the guidelines process. The award consists of a plaque and is given annually to one individual. If no suitable candidate is nominated for the award, it may be withheld in any given year.

Eligibility: Eligible candidates are Hypertension Canada members; the member awardee could be a representative of a team or organizational effort. Members of the Hypertension Canada Awards Committee and Board are not eligible.

Selection Criteria and Process: Eligible individuals or organizations must be nominated. Self-nominations will only be accepted under unique circumstances and must be justified within the nomination documents. Nominations are valid only for the year in which the nomination is submitted. There is no limit on the number of Hypertension Innovation Awards that an individual or organization may receive, but more than one award will only be awarded under unusual circumstances and for activities or initiatives that are unique or exceptional.

A letter of nomination and supporting documents must be submitted electronically to Hypertension Canada at info@hypertension.ca prior to the nomination deadline to be considered. Submissions received after the deadline will not be considered.

The letter of nomination should clearly outline the extent, duration, and the impact of contributions to increased public awareness, prevention, or control of hypertension.

Selection: The Awards Committee will review the letters of nomination and documents submitted in support of the nominations and will select recipients by consensus.

The award will be announced at our Canadian Hypertension Congress in the spring.

The deadline for submission of these nominations is January 17th, 2025.
